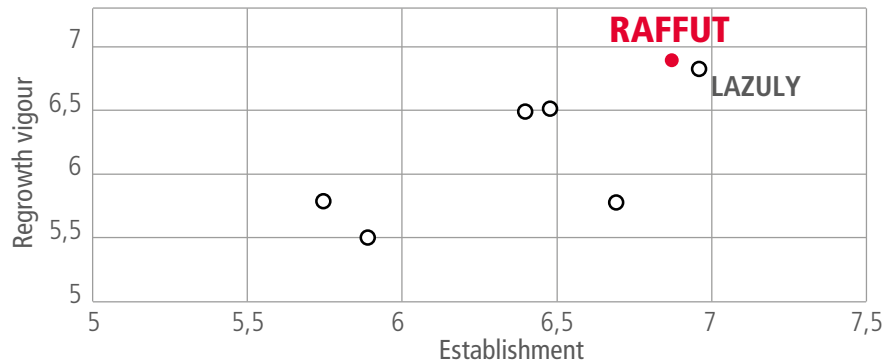
GOOD PRODUCTIVITY
