



## VERY GOOD BEHAVIOUR IN ASSOCIATION WITH GRASSES

Finding a good balance between clover and grass in mixtures is a major issue and selecting good white clover is essential! **RGT GABBY has very good establishment and regrowth vigour** after grazing or a cut, improving its ability to compete with the grasses. It is also not too aggressive, thereby creating a better balance in the sward.

**RGT GABBY** has particularly good winter hardiness helping to preserve a good proportion of clover after a tough winter.
